

## How many students received support from the funding in 2017/18?

- 10 students received interventions for literacy
- 22 Students received interventions for literacy and numeracy

## Spend 2017/18

For the 2017-18 academic year, the school received £5,545 towards raising students' progress in literacy and numeracy.

### Literacy Interventions Impact

26 students received literacy interventions focusing on either their reading skills or spelling, punctuation and grammar.

Students' reading scores were assessed at the beginning and again at the end of the intervention and analysis showed that 77% of students made progress. 88% of students made progress across the year when comparing their English grades in lesson; 54% of these students made at least 2 sublevels of progress.

### Numeracy Interventions Impact

90% of students improved their ability to add and subtract whole numbers.

90% of students improved on subtracting decimals.

40% of students achieved or exceeded their aspirational end of year target.

47% of students were just one sub level below their aspirational end of year target.

Areas for further development for this group of students in year 8 are long multiplication and addition of decimals as only 40% of students showed improvement in this area.
